Prospective Firms/Individuals are hereby notified of the following response to the inquiry received from WIPRO dated August 18, 2010:

1.) QUESTION:

At this moment, Wipro isn't compliant with a few legal/contractual requirements of the RFP (for example - affirmative action requirements, American Disability Act compliance, Guam Business license). Would Guam Power Authority encourage Wipro to bid as a prime contractor in this case?

ANSWER:

Evaluation of each proponent shall include Legal/contractual requirements compliance. Non-compliance with any requirement may be used as basis for evaluating the proponent as unqualified or unresponsive.

2.) QUESTION:

In-case Wipro doesn't meet the compliance requirements as a Prime Contractor; can Wipro partner a local compliant vendor (who will prime the contract) as a sub-contractor?

ANSWER:

Yes.

3.) **QUESTION:**

We understand that GPA is keen to implement JD Edwards/Utiligy solution. However, JD Edwards is in the process of being phased out (post its acquisition by Oracle). From our experience with Utilities across the globe, we can clearly see a trend towards SAP and Oracle CIS solutions. Would GPA be open to explore these solutions?

ANSWER:

GPA will be willing to explore these solutions.
