RESOURCE PLAN (IRP)

COMES NOW, the GUAM POWER AUTHORITY (GPA), by and through its counsel of record, D. GRAHAM BOTHA, ESQ., and hereby submits GPA's Draft Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). GPA's Integrated Resource Plan intends to provide the lowest cost power for customers, fuel diversity, in an environmentally responsible manner. The primary recommendations of the IRP include award wind or renewable energy projects by December 2009; bring LNG as a substitute fuel for diesel fuel oil by 2012; plan and permit for an additional gas-fired or non-petroleum-fired plant; find a business partner to develop the Guam Sea Water Air Conditioning project; and continue to evaluate renewable and energy efficient technologies, including geothermal, Ocean Thermal Energy Conversion (OTEC), and Integrated Gasification Combined Cycle (IGCC).
